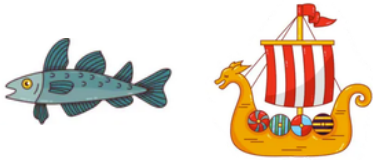

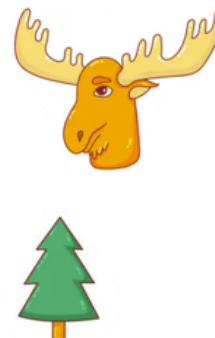

Norway's Historic World Cup Run Wraps at 5th Place

Norway finished the 2026 FIFA World Cup with a final tournament placement in the quarter-finals, positioning them 5th overall in the tournament's 48-team descending performance ranking. Following this historic run, the Official FIFA World Rankings updated Norway to 19th place globally, marking a massive jump of 12 spots.
